Medical Attendance

A total of 530 cases have been managed since 8 Dec' 93 till 28 Mar' 95, onboard MVStepan Krasheninnikov, at Maitri, and onboard MVPolar Bird. Most of the cases barring a few major ones have been minor. All the cases have responded well to treatment. The number of cases involving injuries, including cold injuries, sprains, and strains have been high, in comparison to the last team. No effort has been spared to provide the best medical care promptly, and within the available resources.

Status of Medical Stores

A thorough check of all stores were carried out, unserviceable items separated and those not on charge, taken on charge. Most of the electrical / mechanical apparatus were serviced and some unserviceable ones reconditioned. Expired drugs / chemicals backloaded.

Health Check-up

Quarterly medical check-ups were carried out for Army personnel. A constant watch was kept on the health status of all members, and necessary advice / treatment given, as and when required.

Reorganisation of Clinic / OT

The clinic and OT were revamped with available resources. Non-essential items were removed to the loft for storage in view of the scarcity of the space.

Radiography

A total of 15 X-rays were taken despite the limitations due to cramped confines of the clinic, non availability of proper X-ray cassettes, expired X-ray films, and vertical cassette holder.

Cooperation with Novolazaravskaya Station

Dr. Boris Derjadin of Novolazaravskaya Station has been of immense help and assistance for management of Dental Cases, Mutual consultations for management of patients were done, as and when required.

Cooperation with AIIMS

The responsibility of Medical Care and the research on Human Physiology was borne jointly by Dr. Arun Joshi of AIIMS, and self. I am grateful to him for conducting biochemical tests, specially LFT for a case of Viral Hepatitis and a case of Pulmonary Tuberculosis. His assistance for conducting surgery was excellent.

Cooperation with XIV ISEA

All members of the XIV Expedition stationed at Maitri were provided Medical Care till the Surgeon and Anesthetist of the new team were inducted. I am grateful to Sqn Ldr S Anant for giving General Anesthesia onboard MV *Polar Bird, for a case of Osteomyelitis toes, probably a first time occurrence* in the history of Indian Antarctic Expeditions. I am also grateful to Maj A Sharma, AMC for providing mutual and maximum cooperation in management of casualties.

Proposal for Hospital Complex at Maitri

Considering the drawbacks faced during the wintering period of which the space constraint was acutely felt, a detailed proposal with justifications for building a Hospital Block has been separately submitted to the DOD Observer onboard MV Polar Bird, Dr. A Mitra, whose concern for improvement of facilities was appreciated.
